LPPD K9 traffic stop results in 2 arrests for Narcotics Violations

On December 2nd, 2017 a La Porte K9 Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 1200 block of West Main Street, La Porte Texas. During the traffic stop, the K9 alerted to the odor of narcotics. The illegal substance was located and believed to be more than 2 grams of powder cocaine and more than 7 grams of illegal pills. The K9 officer, through further investigation, was able to link the narcotics to Justin Laron Fisher and Candice Jhanique Jackson, both residence of La Porte Texas. The Harris County District Attorney's Office was contacted and the charge for Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance was filed on both suspects.

The La Porte Police Department's K9 Units are dedicated to proactively seeking out, and responding to any and all suspected narcotic related activity in the city. With each transaction spoiled, the unit communicates a clear message to those involved in the possession of illegal narcotics, that activity of this nature is not tolerated in the City of La Porte.
