

## LPPD Makes Arrest for Possession In Drug-Free Zone

The La Porte Police Department has released the arrest reports for the dates of April 19-28.

Brice was determined to be above the legal limit while operating a motor vehicle and officers subsequently took him into custody for processing on one count of driving while intoxicated.
