



La Porte Police Make Arrest for Failure to Stop, Possession

The La Porte Police Department has released the arrest reports for the week of May 27-June 2.

- On May 27 at 12:30 a.m. La Porte Police officer arrested 31-year-old Christina Allen after an automobile collision near the 3000 block of North 23rd Street. Officers determined that Allen had been involved in the collision and allegedly attempted to flee the scene. Allen was subsequently taken into custody for processing on one count of misdemeanor failure to stop and give information.
- On May 27 at 7:14 p.m. LPPD Officers arrested 25-year-old Leslie Taylor of La Porte after investigating an alleged possession of a controlled substance case near the 9500 block of Spencer Highway in La Porte. Officers allegedly located a quantity of an illegal substance on the person of Taylor and she was taken into custody for processing on one count of possession of a controlled substance.
- On May 27 at 7:14 p.m. LPPD Officers arrested 34-year-old Charles Rowton of La Porte after investigating an alleged possession of a controlled substance case near the 9500 block of Spencer Highway in La Porte. Officers allegedly located a quantity of an illegal substance on the person of Rowton and he was taken into custody for processing on one count of possession of a controlled substance.
- On May 29 at 11:27 p.m. La Porte Police officers arrested 28-year-old Amber Pharis Sinks of La Porte after investigating an alleged incident in which the suspect took several items from a business without making purchase.
